Real Property Tax Rates

The Comptroller's Office recently released its annual property tax data. A table and chart with 2010 property tax rates for the Region's municipalities appear on the following pages. Please see <http://www.osc.state.ny.us/localgov/orptbook/taxrates.htm> for more detail.

A range for school district rates is given when more than one district serves a municipality. An average tax rate is used where towns or cities have established special homestead and non-homestead units for assessing real property for municipal and/or school district purposes. Rates for special assessment districts such as fire, sewer, and water districts are omitted, since their boundaries rarely coincide with one another or with the boundaries of the unincorporated areas.

Overall *full value rates* are determined by multiplying the total overall rate or range by the equalization rate except for villages, where the village equalization rate only applies to the village tax rate. The town equalization rate applies to county, town, and school tax rates.

Equalization rates represent the average relationship of the total assessed value of taxable real property to the total market value of that property.

An equalization rate of 1.00000 means *average* assessed value equals *average* total market value, based on a sample survey. Equalization rates greater than one (>1) for a municipality indicate a decline in average total market value within a taxing jurisdiction or insufficient data on average market values following a recent full-value reassessment.

Finally, a decline in full value rates from a previous year generally reflects an increase in total market values, not lower taxes for individual properties.

Existing Home Sales

For 2010, unit sales of existing homes in the Capital District through the Capital Region Multiple Listing Service declined from the previous year by 7.4%, or 490 sales. Average days to sale for 2010 rose by 1.3% from 82.1 to 83.1 days, suggesting a further moderate decline in the market for sellers.

The mean 2010 constant-dollar selling price for existing homes in the Capital Region rose by \$5,572 to \$228,424, a 2.5% increase. The median 2010 constant-dollar selling price for existing homes in the Capital Region rose by \$1,953 or 1.0% since 2009, to \$192,528. This represents the first annual increase in three years.

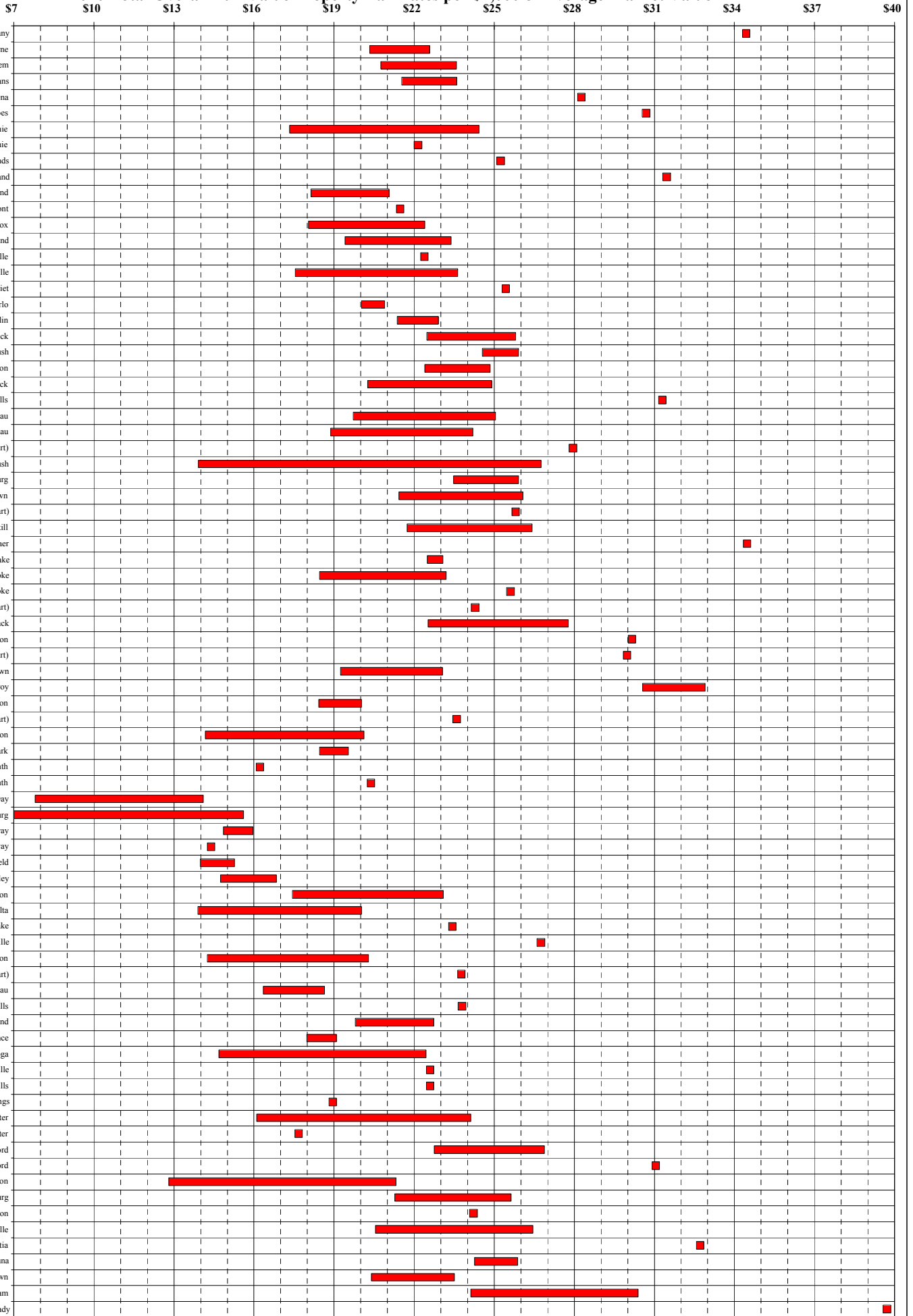

2010 Census PL94-171 Redistricting Data

On March 24th, the Census Bureau released the 2010 Census PL 994-171 redistricting data for the State of New York. 2010 Census population counts of total persons by race, Hispanic origin, and voting age are now available for geographies down to the census block level. Housing unit counts by occupancy or vacancy status are also available.

The first of the following tables identifies the 2010 Census population counts for the Capital Region's 79 municipalities. Note that the town totals include village totals. The population counts are listed by race and Hispanic origin. The category titled 'Total Minority' represents the total population less the white non-Hispanic population. Of the four counties, Albany County had the largest percent of minorities, while Saratoga County had the smallest.

The second table identifies the 2000 and 2010 population counts, and the net and percent change from 2000-10 for municipalities in the Region. Overall, the Capital Region has grown 5.5% since 2000. All of the Region's eight cities increased, reversing a 50-year trend of declining urban populations. Rural towns, such as Petersburg, Day, and Westerlo, were more likely to lose population. Half of the villages in the Region lost population.

Note that part of the explanation for higher property tax rates in cities and some villages is that they are more likely to include basic services such as fire, water, sewer, and trash collection in the overall property tax rate, while suburban and rural municipalities either do not provide these services or are likely to form special assessment districts to recover the costs of such services.

In addition, an individual's tax burden may vary significantly in relation to properties of similar market value, despite the adjustment provided for by the equalization rate. The data used to derive the equalization rate are not necessarily current, and, contrary to New York State Law, the practices of assessing jurisdictions may result in unequal tax burdens on individual property owners with similar properties. The problem is compounded by school district boundaries, which in most cases extend beyond municipal boundaries, and, in a few instances, beyond county boundaries. A community's assessment procedures should be carefully reviewed to determine the impact of its tax rates, including those for special districts, on individual properties. For clarification of the assessment practices within a particular community, contact the community's local assessor.
